FROM THE STATION MANAGER'S DESK:

God has blessed us this summer as we have the opportunity to have two of our grandchildren stay with us on separate weeks. God was making it very clear that He wanted us to completely trust in Him.

We are learning to love God more every day, along with trusting and depending on Him for all our needs. God wants us to give Him our attention as He leads in the plans He has for us. Our journey from Florida to Connecticut and the time we have been here over the past two years have been interesting ones. There is no doubt in our minds that God is trying to teach us something. We don't know what that might be at this time. He has the big picture; we only see parts of the big picture. I don't want to settle for what we think is good for us. I want God's best.

I don't know what God is doing in your life, what His big picture is for you. But are you seeing parts of what He is doing? Trust Him and He will direct your paths (Proverbs 3: 5-6). Let Him work out His plans in your life no matter how rough the path may seem. See what He wants to accomplish in you. Let Him work out His best for you.

A passage of Scripture that is meaningful to him is Philippians 3:8-10 *“Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ, And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death...”* Be sure and visit Matthew’s ministry display table at the **WIHS** Banquet!!
