WIHS regularly invites local evangelical pastors to participate in Bread of Life. Each pastor prepares seven consecutive days of five-minute devotional messages. Bread of Life airs:

- Sundays at 1:05 am, 7:15 am and 3:55 pm

SACRED PERFORMANCE

Sacred Performance airs on WIHS Sundays at 1:30 am and 1:00 pm. The music presented gives glory to the Father, Son and Holy Spirit tapping into the reservoir of sacred music through the centuries. Sacred Performance is a journey of discovery, as we traverse music of different styles and genres to examine how music can give glory to God. We also seek to inform listeners about the composers and the inspiration behind their compositions. The program considers classical and contemporary styles, using a lecture and listen format. WIHS provides nearly 85 hours of music each week! Two of those hours are dedicated to music requests from listeners, who may submit their song requests by phone, email, mail or through our website. Airs Saturdays at 7:30 pm and Sundays at 4:30 pm.

PRAYER CIRCLE

WIHS went on the air in 1969 after seven years of prayer! On Saturdays at 8:30 pm, we spend 30 minutes sharing and praying over recent listener prayer requests.
