Exciting WIHS Facility News

After several months of renovation, we're putting the finishing touches on our new conference room!

In 55 years, we've never had an in-house space like this to meet with staff, Board members, pastors, tour groups and other guests. This room will be very beneficial as we continue to build relationships with Christians and various organizations across the state. We may be high-tech, but we're also high-touch! Many thanks to those who helped through donations of funds, furniture, expertise and time.



Powered by the Son and the sun? WIHS is currently

conducting a feasibility study on converting our complete electrical, cooling and heating systems to solar power. As you can imagine, between our station and our transmitter, we use a lot of juice!

Instead of installing solar panels on our roof, or converting our field into a solar panel "farm," we're focusing our study on two solar panel sun trackers for the station and transmitter. The 54-panel arrays would "follow" the sun as it moves across the sky to capture the optimal amount of solar power year-round. It looks

like we'd generate enough grid-connected photovoltaic (PV) power for everything! If you are interested in helping to provide seed money for this project, please contact the station today!

We are blessed with property that includes a gently sloped field that could

be transformed into a natural "ampitheater," along with flatter land near the road and building that could be used for parking, exhibitor tents, food trucks and porta-potties. What if we did some minor grading work, rented a stage and AV system, and held "live" Christian concerts, festivals and evangelistic outreaches? These events would help to unite and expand the statewide

Body of Christ and introduce attendees to WIHS. Later this year, we'll be exploring the feasibility of hosting future events. If you are interested in helping to fund site prep and events, please contact the station today.


