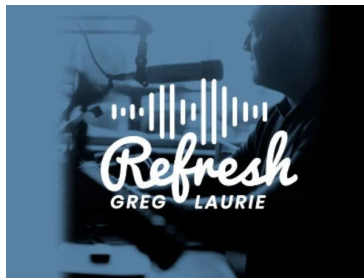


Katherine Burchard

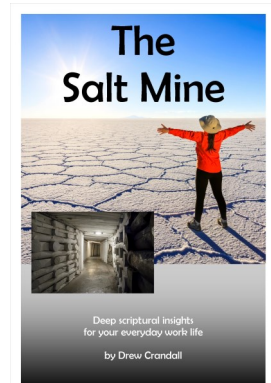
